13. COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Councillor Mary Evans distributed copies of the proposed plan for Chevron Signs on the A143 bend at the Elm Farm turning. Also 'SLOW' will be written on the road and white line painted both sides of the bend which is hoped will slow the traffic, therefore, reduce the accidents at this location. This is the recommendation of a Traffic Consultant. To change the speed limit is a long process.

The meeting was temporarily closed so Dr Huck could take part in the discussion. He asked if the Clerk would keep a log of all accidents (includes those with no injuries) which she agreed to do.

The County Council have agreed to put a 'No Overnight Parking' sign in the Lay-by near the Plant Nursery. This should reduce the noise from refrigerated lorries.

School GCE results for the County have improved. A meeting concerning the broadband speed is soon to take place to discuss the date for better broadband speed for the area. Councillor Evans asked if Depden had experienced any flooding problems.

Following the road closures in Clare, due to installation of new gas pipes, they are holding an Open Day Saturday 12 September with shops offering discounts.

Councillor Bibby asked if the large pot holes in the lay-by opposite his home could be repaired.

14. BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Councillor Pollington reported that devolution is being discussed which should save money as the loss of government funding is 1.9m but a saving of only 1.4m has been made. The provision of Brown Bins may cost residents £35 per year.

There followed a discussion about Kelly Meadow with Councillor Evans and Councillor Pollington because the Borough Council had proposed that work starts on 9 September even though the issue of the highway 'line of sight' on the A143 has not been resolved. The Councillors have managed to delay the work until a meeting to be held 30 September to discuss the whole issue including size of the development and management.

Councillor Pollington reminded the meeting of the Locality Fund for £500.

The meeting agreed to write a letter to the Borough Council expressing concerns about the highways and management issues regarding Kellys Meadow.
