- 17.1 The Compound has been painted blue which is the colour of Anglian Water. They have started laying the pipeline. An exit strategy is in place. Drilling under the A143 is due to start in two weeks.
- **17.2** Councillor Read informed the meeting he proposes to try and retain the entrance to the compound as an entrance to the field he farms; subject to planning consent.
- **17.3** There has been additional use of Elms Farm Lane due to additional work on the road across the airfield.
- 17.4 Councillor Ebbens expressed concern about the length of the grass at the turning to Elms Farm Lane from the A143. Councillor Read said he would ask Anglian Water to arrange for this to be cut for safety reasons.

- **17.5** They had also been damage to a Chevron Sign on the A143 this will be reported to Suffolk Highways.
- **18. DEFIBRILLATOR AT THE CARE FARM.** This now fully installed.
